कृपया स्टेट ट्रांसफॉर्मेशन कमीशन-1 (नियोजन विभाग), उ०प्र० शासन के शासनादेश दिनांक: 24 मई, 2022 एवं दिनांक: 12 जुलाई, 2022 का संदर्भ ग्रहण करने का कष्ट करें, जिनके द्वारा 05 विषयगत क्षेत्र यथा- चिकित्सा एवं पोषण, शिक्षा, कृषि एवं जल संसाधन, वित्तीय समावेशन एवं कौशल विकास तथा आधारभूत अवसंरचना के अंतर्गत कुल 75 इंडीकेटर्स के आधार पर प्रदेश के चयनित 100 आकांक्षात्मक विकास खण्डों की प्रगति का अनुश्रवण किया जा रहा है।

2- नीति आयोग, भारत सरकार द्वारा देश के सभी राज्यों के चयनित 500 विकास खण्डों हेतु Aspirational Blocks Programme संचालित किये जाने का निर्णय लिया गया है। Aspirational Blocks Programme (ABP) के अन्तर्गत सामाजिक एवं आर्थिक इंडीकेटर्स के आधार पर देश के कुल 500 पिछड़े विकास खण्डों का चयन किया गया है। उक्त Aspirational Blocks Programme (ABP) के अन्तर्गत प्रदेश के 42 जनपदों के 68 विकास खण्डों (सूची संलग्न) का चयन किया गया है, जिसमें 60 विकास खण्ड उत्तर प्रदेश आकांक्षात्मक विकास खण्ड कार्यक्रम में चयनित आकांक्षात्मक विकास खण्ड हैं तथा शेष 08 विकास खण्ड, प्रदेश के 08 महत्वाकांक्षी जनपदों से सम्बन्धित हैं।
