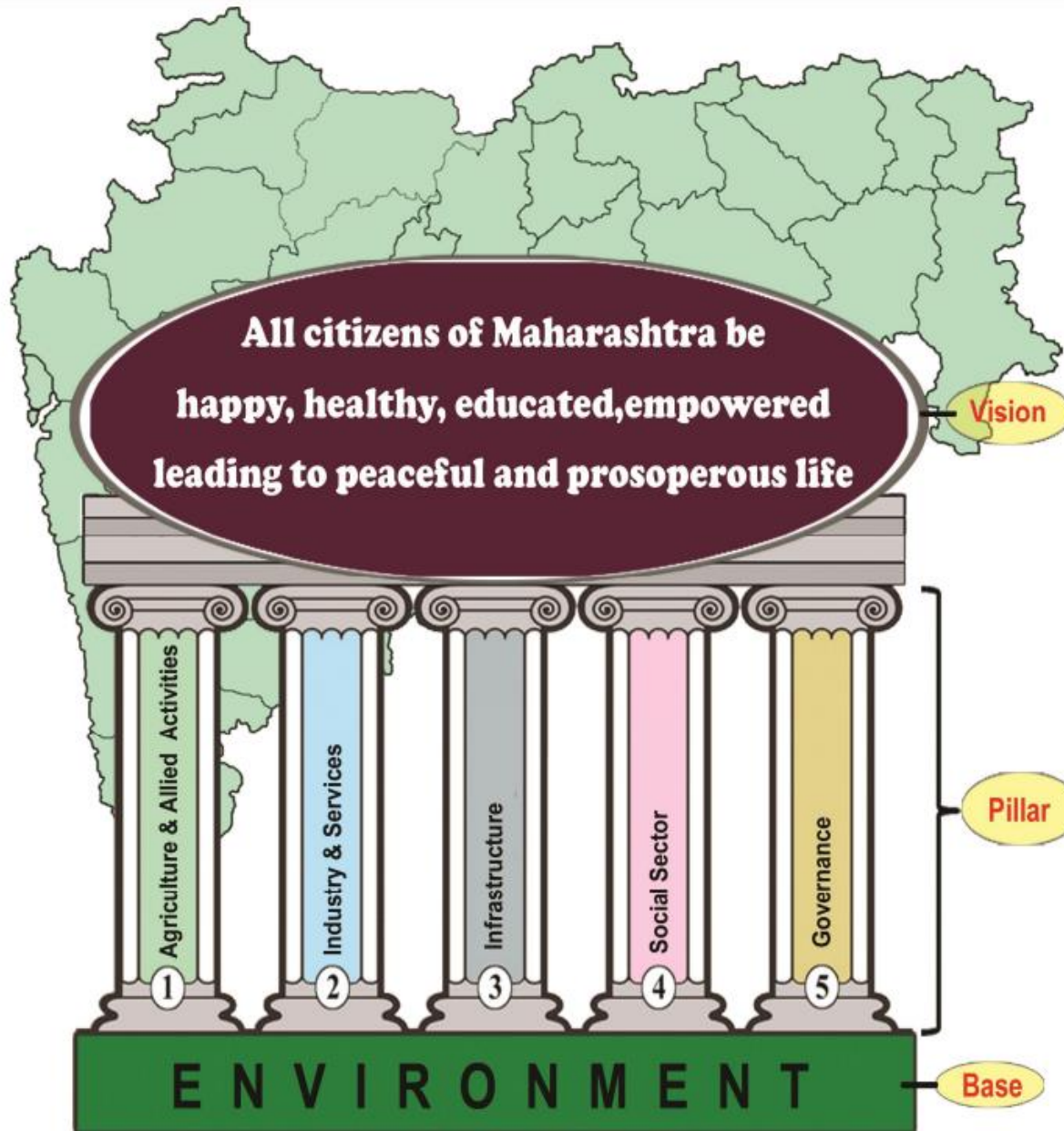

- ❑ State constitutes 9.3% of population of India and ranks second after UP
- ❑ The proportion of urban population is 45.2 per cent
- ❑ About 63 per cent of the State population belongs to working age group (15-59 years)
- ❑ Sex ratio in rural areas is 952 and in urban areas 903 (Concern).
- ❑ Literacy rate of the State is 82.3 per cent.
- ❑ The State has 36 districts, 2 are urban and 34 rural so 34 ZPs divided into 6 revenue divisions.

Vision 2030 for the state



- ❑ Maharashtra has prepared a Vision 2030 document for SDGs in 2016 and submitted in 2017
- ❑ The fundamental principle of the vision is sustainable, balanced and all inclusive socio-economic growth of the State.
- ❑ Core five pillars of Vision 2030 are:
 - *Agriculture and allied activities*
 - *Industry*
 - *Infrastructure*
 - *Social Sector*
 - *Governance*
- ❑ Climate change has necessitated it to have environment as base for all the five pillars

Institutional arrangement for SDGs (State)

- ❑ Sustainable Development Goals- Implementation and Coordination Centre (SDG-ICC)
 - On 3rd of December, 2020, Government of Maharashtra established 'Sustainable Development Goals- Implementation and Coordination Centre' (SDG-ICC) under the Directorate of Economics and Statistics of Planning Department

- ❑ SDG Centre in YASHADA, Pune
 - DoP issued GR on Nov 30, 2021 to establish SDG Centre in YASHADA, apex training institute of MH
 - It focuses on 3 areas- a. Training and workshops, b. Resource material preparation, c. Research including pilots, action research
 - Director, SIRD heads the Centre as Director of the Centre

- ❑ Thematic Committees (6) under the Chairmanship of Chief Secretary for review of SDGs
 - In line with the Vision 2030 Document, DoP, GoM issued GR on May 24, 2022 to guide and review progress on SDGs in the state
 - The 6 committees are a. Agriculture and allied activities, b. Industry, c. Infrastructure, d. Social Sector, e. Governance, f. Environment

Policy environment in RDD for SDG localisation

- ❑ In view of the SDGs, RDD issued GR on Sep 30, 2020 to pilot a model in 83 GPs in partnership with UNICEF aiming at making GPs-
 - Child Friendly Panchayat
 - Gender Friendly Panchayat
 - Socially Secured Panchayat

(These ideas recently became 3 themes which has already been initiated by RDD-UNICEF in 2020)
- ❑ RDD further issued guidelines on 10.02.2021 to integrate SDGs into GPDP focussing risk informed planning for disaster risk reduction aspect
- ❑ RDD has formed Committee under the Chairmanship of ACS to guide, supervise these initiatives for replication of CGFP pilot

- ❑ RDD issued letter on Apr 8, 2022 to conduct Bal Sabhas in all GPs to ensure child participation in governance and decision making.
- ❑ GR issued on Sep 19, 2018 to conduct Bal Sabhas for GPDP planning. State has Bal Panchayats formed in many GPs.
- ❑ State through SIRD has created 142 Master Trainers in all the district on child and gender friendly panchayats
- ❑ 351 Model villages, one GP per Block is being piloted to implement SDGs and convergent planning through GPDP
- ❑ RGSA 2022 plan for the state has thematic training component to all stakeholders

Institutional arrangement for SDG localisation (RDD-SIRD)

- ❑ Expert Committee formed at SIRD, YASHADA under the Chairmanship of Director, SIRD
 - Committee consists of State Project Director, RGSA, SIRD Faculties, UNICEF representatives and external subject experts to devise SDG localisation strategies on CB needs, implementation framework including modelling and piloting, convergence efforts, documentation and monitoring mechanisms.
 - Committee meets every fortnightly
 - It proposes to create a 'knowledge network of experts for SDG localisation and Social Policy initiatives for the state' in partnership with UNICEF.

- ❑ SDG Centre in YASHADA, Pune
 - Director, SIRD heads the Centre as Director of the Centre
 - This centre coordinates efforts between DoP-Nodal Dept for SDG and RDD-Nodal dept for localisation of SDGs in PRIs

- ❑ Thematic Working Groups for SDG localisation
 - SIRD has formed working groups under each SIRD Faculty to work on 9 SDG themes.
 - Each working group is responsible for reviewing thematic modules, developing training plans and disseminating it to GPs through various trainings.

Action towards SDGs in PRIs

- ☐ Consultations, TNAs, ToTs and workshops on SDG localisation in PRIs
 - **Oct'21**- 3 day TNA for Child and Gender Friendly Panchayat organised. Modules developed in Marathi
 - **Marc'22**-Brainstorming sessions-2 organised with experts and district/block officials and PRI Ers
 - **Apr'22**- SDG centric GPDP/BPDP/DPDP preparation workshop for module devt. Design finalised
 - **May'22**- ToT for 30 Master Trainers conducted based on the modules prepared on CGFP
 - **May'22**- 4 day TNA organised in partnership with UNICEF to identify needs and prepare design for thematic modules for GPs. Design finalised.
 - **Jun'22**- Thematic Module development writeshop organised between Jn 2-4 by SIRD-UNICEF

Steps taken for SDGs in the state

Capacity Building

1% fund of District Annual Plan has been made available for the training and capacity building on SDGs at district level

Module for district and block officials developed by Yashada through SDG Centre

Women and child Centric SDG Module with UNICEF

Training of the officials

GoM has directed YASHADA to incorporate SDGs in the training modules for officers of Group 1 and 2.

More than 1200 officials from Planning Department have received one day orientation on SDGs

Mapping of state level schemes to SDGs and targets

A separate tab has been made available on Maharashtra Plan Schemes Information Management System (MP-SIMS) for providing information about SDGs and targets relevant to the respective schemes

More than 1600 State level schemes have been mapped with SDGs and targets. Based on the analysis of this scheme mapping exercise, a report has been prepared which has been approved by the state government and will be published soon.

Steps taken Cont'd.....

Monitoring framework for SDGs

State Indicator Framework (SIF) has been finalised consisting of 237 indicators to track SDGs related progress at the state level.

Draft of District Indicator Framework (DIF) has been prepared by SDG-ICC which presently consists of 119 indicators.

Awareness generation

SDGs related important documents have been made available on the website of Planning Department
RGSA developed posters on SDG themes

IEC plan is being worked out in YASHADA in partnership with UNICEF

Accountability fixed

Nodal and supporting departments have been finalised for all the SDGs

Concerned Departments to form committee to look after implementation of the SDGs

- ❑ Maharashtra is the second largest state in India in terms of population with 11.24 crore as per 2011 census.
- ❑ Rural population was 6.15 crore (54.7%).
- ❑ The State has 36 districts divided into 6 revenue divisions.
- ❑ Average per GP population of the state works out to be around 2,204.
- ❑ Local self-governance in urban areas are governed through 26 Municipal Corporations, 230 Municipal Councils, 111 Nagar Panchayats and seven Cantonment Boards.



Steps taken for SDG localisation in the state

Translation and availability of resource material in Marathi

- Resource books titled “SDGs and GPs’ prepared by MoPR
- Child and Gender Friendly Panchayat training modules (3) for children, women, and GPs
- Expert Committee on SDG localisation reports (On going)
- 9 Themes PPTs and dissemination to GPs
- Brochure on localisation of SDGs and circulated to all GPs

Consultations and TNAs, ToTs organised

- Two brainstorming consultations, one with experts and other with GP stakeholders organised in Mar
- 4 day TNA/writeshop conducted for *thematic module development, LIF prioritization, and IEC material development* in partnership with UNICEF on May 11-14
- ToT with 30 MTs CGFP

Module Development initiatives

- Draft module on ‘Poverty Free GP’ in English is prepared
- Modules on Child and Gender Friendly Panchayats finalised
- Design of 9 thematic modules finalised and being further developed by SIRD
- Low cost-No cost activity mapping done for Child and Gender Friendly Panchayats
- GPDP-SDG module design ready

- Monthly meetings in all GPs b/w Apr 11-17
- Poster making competitions
- Gram Sabhas and Bal Sabhas in all GPs
- Documentaries on various SDGs themes prepared
- RGSA plan having thematic focussed

Monitoring framework for GPs

- LIF prioritisation for GPs is in progress
- Maharashtra GP Monitoring system is being piloted in Kagal Block based on SDGs/Social indicators in partnership with UNICEF
- Web based monitoring system allows data based and community led monitoring too
- System is being further developed in view of LIF

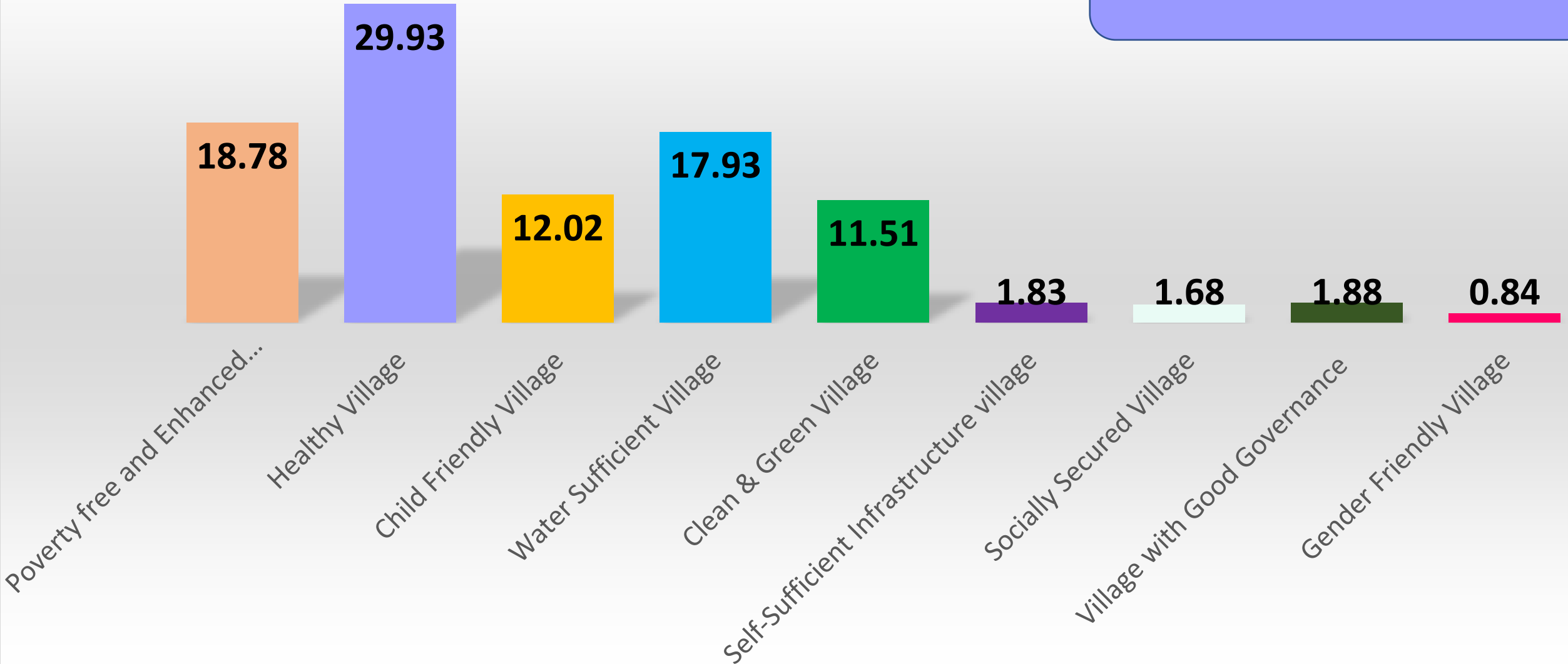
Awareness generation/IEC

Thematic Sankalp by GPs in the state

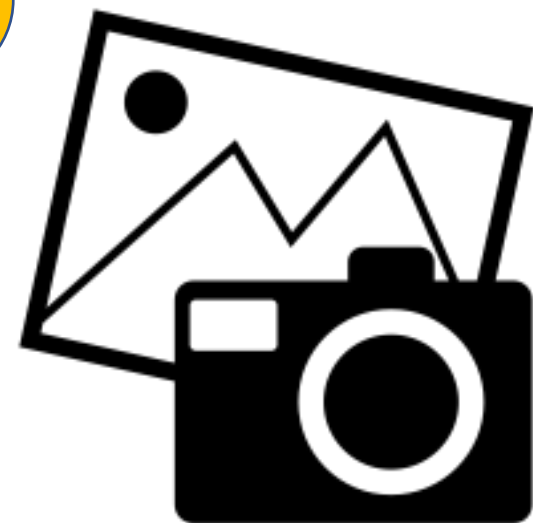
Thematic Sankalp by GPs in Maharashtra (in %)

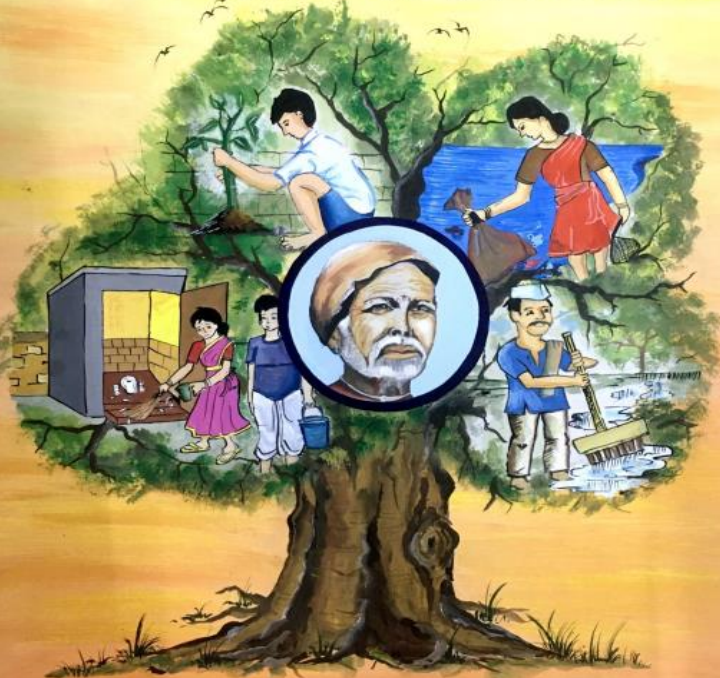

तेरावा राष्ट्रीय पंचायतराज दिन

राज्य सरकारच्या अधिकारांचे विकेंद्रीकरण करून पंचायतराज संस्थाना अधिकाधिक स्वायत्तता देण्याच्या उद्देशाने केंद्र सरकारने २४ एप्रिल १९९३ म ७३ वी घटनादुरुस्ती केली. या घटनादुरुस्तीचा प्रत्यक्ष अंमलबजावणी १९९४ पासून सुरू झाली आहे. ७३ व्या घटनादुरुस्तीचा दिवस हा राष्ट्रीय पंचायतराज दिन म्हणून साजरा करण्याचा निर्णय तत्कालीन पंतप्रधान डॉ. मनमोहनसिंग यांनी सन २०१० मध्ये घेतला. या निर्णयानुसार २४ एप्रिल २०१० रोजी देशातील पहिला राष्ट्रीय पंचायतराज दिन साजरा करण्यात आला. येल्या रविवारी साजरा होत असलेला यंदाचा तेरावा राष्ट्रीय पंचायतराज दिन आहे.
